

## **Project Arts Centre – Procurement Policy**

Project Arts Centre CLG is complying in full with all applicable responsibilities of an Arts Council Grantee set out in section 5 of the [Department of Public Expenditure and Reform Circular 13/2014](#). The company is adhering to the Statement of Principles set out in Appendix 2 of this Circular as well as the Public Procurement Guidelines for Goods and Services. The company ensures that the appropriate governance and oversight arrangements at board and employee level are in place for the procurement of goods or services.

It should be noted that the exemption detailed on Page 52 of the [guidelines](#), Negotiated Procedure without Prior Publication, applies when ‘the aim of their procurement is the creation or acquisition of a unique work of art or artistic performance and can only be supplied by a particular supplier or service provider’. Exempted activities of Project Arts Centre CLG include the creation and direction of artistic programmes, performances, conferences, exhibitions, events, training, artist residencies, workshops and other forms of artist support. These are arranged adhering to best practice in the visual and performing arts sectors.
