Page 1 - What is this document

Page 2 - Outside Project

1 - This is the outside of Project Arts Centre.

It is located on East Essex Street in Temple Bar, Dublin 2.

It is a big blue building with a glass front.



2 - You can enter through the big glass door.

There is a big blue 'a' on the door.

Sometimes there is a security guard standing next to or near the door.



3 - There is a button to the left of the entrance that you can press to open the door if you want it to. Once you press it the door will open slowly.

After you go into the building, the door will close automatically behind you.



Page 3 - Inside Project (Downstairs)

4 - When you go in the building, you will be on the ground floor.

It is a big open space with seating areas, an information desk, a lift, stairs and access to toilets. Sometimes people wait or chat here.

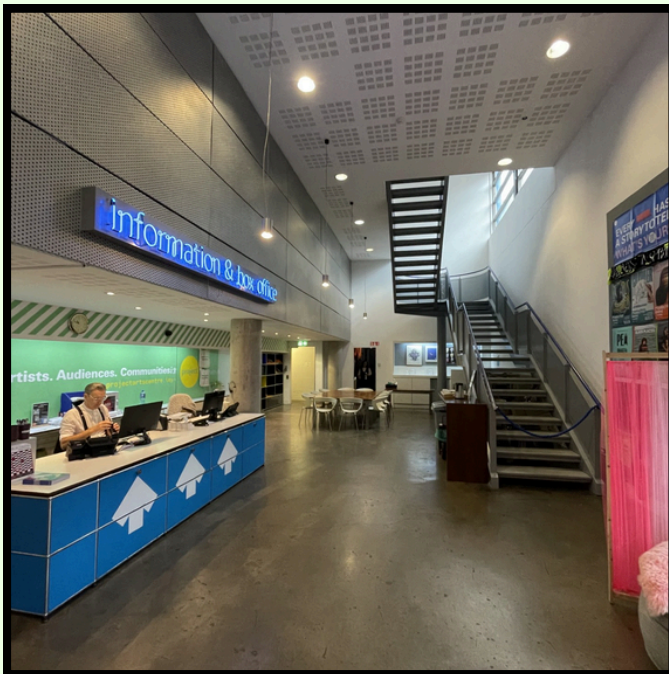
5 - There is a lift next to the entrance. You can use it to get to the launch.

The launch will be on Floor 1.

You will only be able to go to Floor 0 and Floor 1. All other floors are for staff.

6 - This is the information desk and box office.

There are some ear defenders, fidget spinners and other materials available at the information desk if you want. Please remember to return them.



Page 4 - Inside Project (Downstairs)

7 - There is a comfy seated area on the other side of the entrance.

Here you will find beanbags and fluffy blanket which you are free to use if you want.



8 - There is a seated area under the stairs.

This area is a bit more private than other parts of the ground floor.

There are some plug points here if you need them.



9 - Toilets are through the yellow door in the corner of the room. There are toilets for all genders and an accessible toilet.

If the door is closed, a member of staff can open it for you from the information desk.



Page 5 - Inside Project (Upstairs)

10 - You can also use the stairs to get to Floor 1. If there is a rope hanging across the bottom step, Floor 1 is not open and you cannot use the stairs.

There are 31 steps. The stairs curve on the way up.



11 - When you get to the top of the stairs there are benches, tables and cushions.

The launch will be in this area. There will be music playing, people chatting and some short speeches.



12 - When you pass the seated area you will see the lift again on your left.

You can use the lift to return to the ground floor or Floor 0 and leave the building if you want.



Page 6 - Inside Project (Upstairs)

13 - Across from the lift there is a small hallway. You will find more toilets down the hallway on the left.

There are toilets for all genders but there is no accessible toilet in this area.

14 - Past the lift and toilets there is a bar and some more seating areas.

Here you can buy drinks and snacks.

A member of staff will be behind the bar.

15 - There is a smoking area next to the bar.

It has some benches and sheltering.

You can take your drinks out here if you want.
