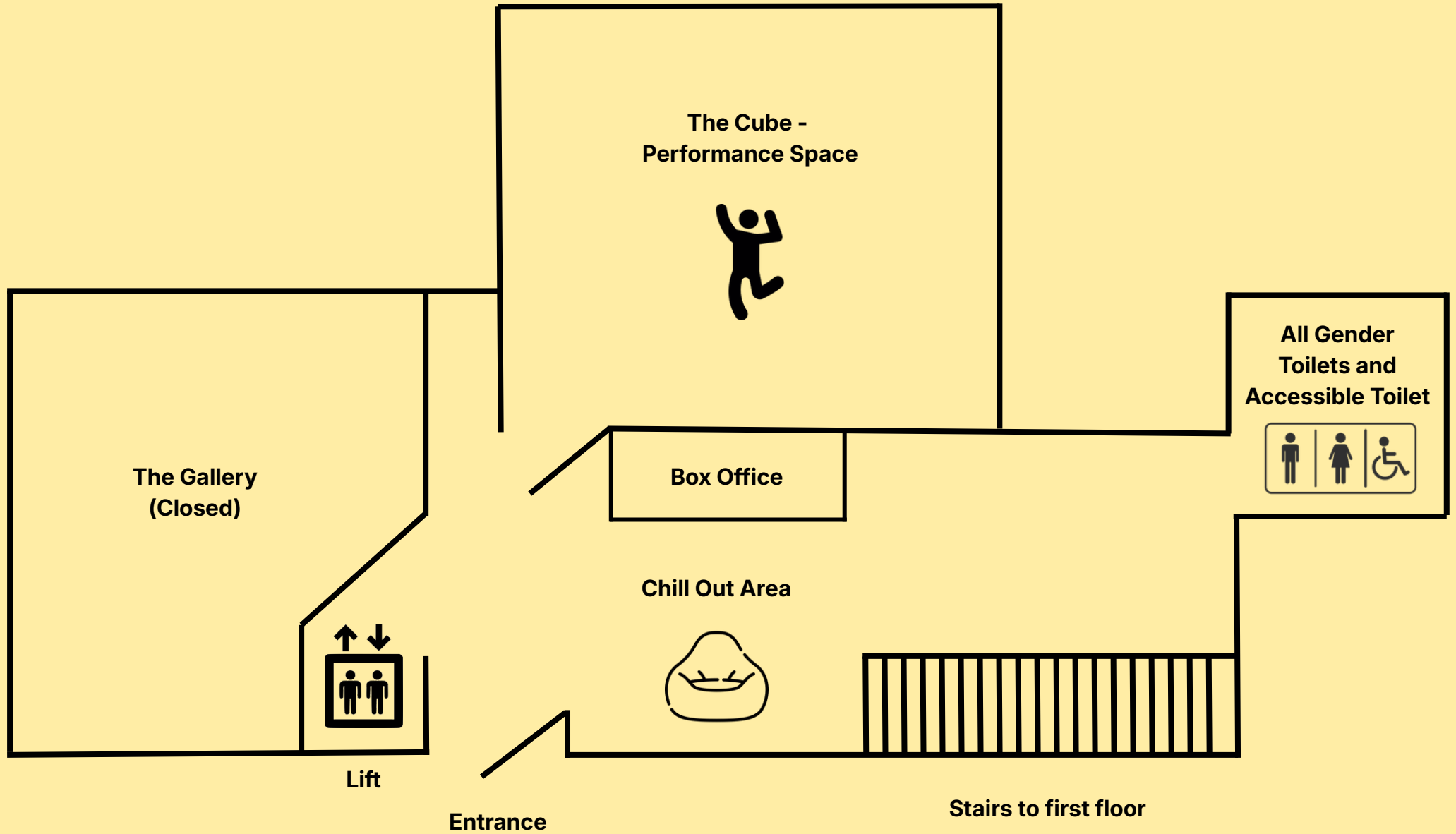

# Page 2 - Ground Floor Map



# Page 3 - Outside Project

**1 - This is the outside of Project Arts Centre.**

**It is located on East Essex Street in Temple Bar, Dublin 2.**

**It is a big blue building with a glass front.**

**2 - You can enter through the big glass door.**

**There is a big blue 'a' on the door.**

**3 - There is a button to the left of the entrance that you can press to open the door if you want it to. Once you press it the door will open slowly.**

**After you go into the building, the door will close automatically behind you.**



# Page 4 - Inside Project

**4 - When you go in the building, you will be on the ground floor.**

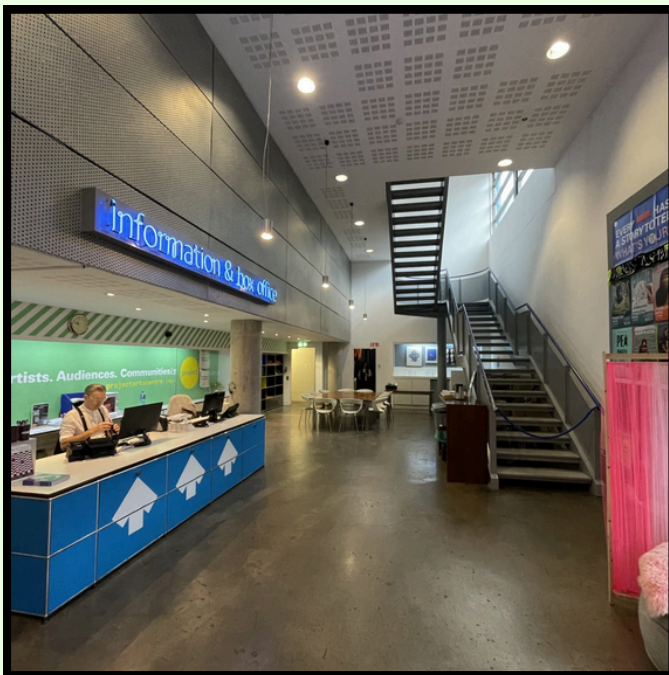
**It is a big open space with seating areas, an information desk, a lift, stairs and access to toilets in the corner of the room.**

**5 - There is a lift next to the entrance. You can use it to get to the performance space, which is on Floor 1.**

**You will only be able to go to Floor 0 and Floor 1 via the lift. All other floors are for staff.**

**6 - This is the information desk and box office.**

**There are some ear defenders, fidget spinners and other materials available at the information desk if you want. Please remember to return them.**



# Page 5 - Inside Project

**7 - There is a comfy seating area on the other side of the entrance.**

**Here you will find beanbags and fluffy blanket which you are free to use if you want.**



**8 - There is a seated area under the stairs.**

**This area is a bit more private than other parts of the ground floor.**

**There are some plug points here if you need them.**



**9 - Toilets are through the yellow door in the corner of the room. There are toilets for all genders and an accessible toilet.**

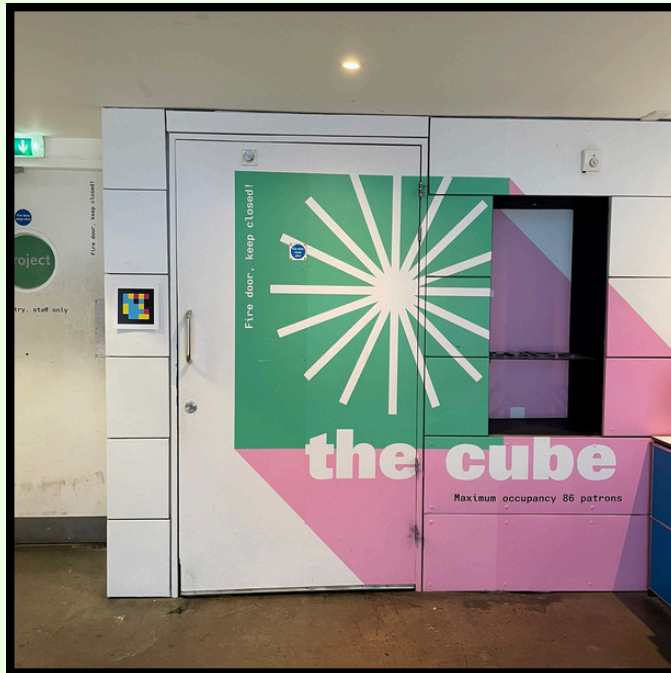
**If the door is closed, a member of staff can open it for you from the information desk.**



# Page 6 - Inside Project (Performance Space)

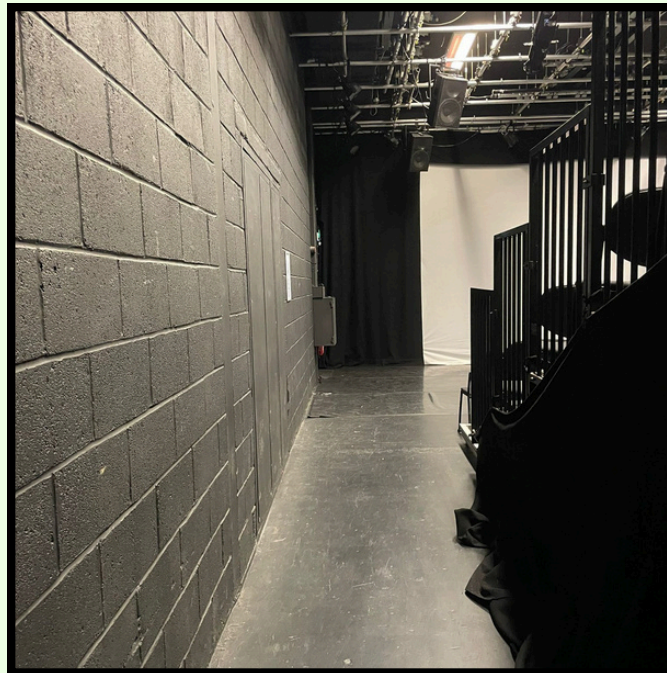
10 - This is the door to The Cube. It is next to the box office. This is where *Drag of Colour: Variety Show* will take place. Once the door is open, audiences can enter.

Audiences must scan their tickets with member of staff on the way in.



11 - Once you enter the space, there will be a short walkway straight ahead.

This will lead you towards the stage along some tiered seating to your right.



12 - There is a walkway in the middle of the seating which angles to the left slightly. No food or drink is allowed in the space.

Once the performance starts, phones must be switched off. A number of breaks will take place during the performance.
